There are two classes:

1. POETRY
2. PROSE

Blue Ribbon \$4 Red Ribbon, \$3 White Ribbon \$2

In either class the categories are:

- 1) Any Subject
- 2) Fair Theme: SPORTS

### RULES:

1. It is required that every entry be in appropriate taste for family and county fair.
2. The work you submit must be your own.
3. Only one entry is allowed for each category.
4. Entries must be submitted Monday, August 9<sup>th</sup> in the Exhibit Building between 8 a.m. and 8 p.m.
5. Submit THREE copies with the following information on the back of each entry.
  - a. Title of entry: (Do not include your name, address or phone #. These go on Entry forms.)
  - b. Class: Poetry or Prose
  - c. Category: Any Subject or Fair Theme: "Sports"
  - d. Age: Your age as of August 9th, 2010.
  - e. Skill Level: Professional, Semi-Pro, Amateur and Special Needs.

### EXAMPLE:

Title: "Sports Your Way"  
Class: Poetry  
Category: Theme  
Age: 10  
Skill Level: Amateur

6. You will be required to sign a Release Form for EACH entry. Forms will be available at registration table.
7. ABSOLUTELY no fancy type or paper. 12 point simple type - white 8 ½ x 11 paper
8. Poetry, single spaced
9. Prose, double spaced, Word limit is 1,200.
10. AWARD PREMIUMS:  
Blue Ribbon \$4  
Red Ribbon, \$3  
White Ribbon \$2  
Poetry & Prose Sweepstakes Ribbon \$20  
Poetry & Prose Reserve Sweepstakes Ribbon \$15  
Chairman's Choice \$10

(In addition to your ribbons and premiums your entry will be judged for prizes, surprises and awards to be presented at our Performance and Award program.)

11. All entrants are expected to attend the Literary Arts Performance and Awards Program held Thursday, August 12<sup>th</sup> at NOON till finished, in the Exhibit Building. You will read your work or you may have someone you designate read it but it must be well rehearsed. Entry must be edited, if necessary to fit the time limit:  
Poetry 7 min., Prose 10 min. Your entry will not be judged on oral presentation.

12. Entries must be picked up Monday, August 16th from 9:00 AM to 6:00 PM at the Fair Grounds. Items left unclaimed will be taken to County Ext. Office to be picked up until August 31<sup>st</sup> 2010.
